

Commercial Centres Revitalisation Project Update #28 - May 2023

Lameroo Town Centre Project (LTCP)

In Lameroo the East End Project works have progressed, the new kerb has been installed, the concrete pedestrian path has been constructed and the remedial asphalting works required to the road edge are complete.

LCS Landscapes will shift their site office to Lameroo towards the end of the month with their focus moving to completing the east end works and starting on the stage 2 & 3 project works.



The new playspace is close to completion which is very exciting. Last month the slides and flying fox were installed. In the coming weeks installation of the rubber soft fall will be completed, the paths will be finished and the garden beds will be planted. An independent playground inspection is being arranged which needs to occur before the playspace can be opened to the community.

At the eastern end of the street two new shelters have been installed and the trees along the street edge have been planted. The picnic setting and paving under the larger shelter has been installed. In the next few weeks the picnic setting and paving under the smaller shelter will be installed and plantings will also occur along the street.
