

Commercial Centres Revitalisation Project Update #37 - March 2024

Lameroo Town Centre Project (LTCP)

In mid-February works began on removing the old railway yard from the Lameroo main street. The removal is progressing well and will continue into March. The area will be returned to open space. Removal of this yard will help open up the view to the silos and improve the main street aesthetic.

Once removal of the railway yard is finished, all of the works under the Lameroo Eastern Entrance project will be complete.

In the coming weeks, the remaining LRCI project, recladding the Lameroo CWA is expected to begin, these works are required to be complete by 30 June 2024.

Pinnaroo Village Green Project (PVGP)

The project works in Pinnaroo were completed in June 2023.

Stage 1 was funded by the Commonwealth Government Department of Industry, Innovation and Science (Commonwealth Drought Extension Programme).

The Eastern Entrance projects are funded by the Commonwealth Government of Infrastructure, Transport, Regional Development and Communications (Local Roads and Community Infrastructure Program).
