

Commercial Centres Revitalisation Project Update #21 - May 2022

Stage 1 Official Opening Events

The official launch of Stage 1 of the Commercial Centre Revitalisation Project was held on Wednesday 27 April. Stage 1 of the Lamerook Town Centre Project was opened at 1pm and it was great to see lots of children enjoying the new recreational spaces at the event. This was followed later in the afternoon in Pinnaroo by the official opening of Stage 1 of the Pinnaroo Village Green Project.

At both events Local MP Tony Pasin and Mayor Nickolls made speeches thanking everyone who contributed to the projects and together they cut the ribbon to formalise the openings. The event provided a great opportunity to acknowledge how fortunate Council was in receiving the Commonwealth Drought Funding that made Stage 1 in both towns possible. A huge thank you to everyone that attended the events.



Pinnaroo Village Green Project (PVGP)

The Pinnaroo Village Green Project Stages 2 & 3 100% detailed design has been approved by Council and is ready to go out to tender. Additional traffic management solutions were installed throughout the Pinnaroo RV parking area and access road prior to Easter. Early reports suggest the new signage, sleepers and bollards has helped to ensure the area is effectively utilised by visitors.

Lamerook Town Centre Project (LTCP)

Over the last month the plans for the Lamerook Town Centre Project Stages 2 & 3 have continued to progress well with 70% detailed design approved at the April Council Meeting. The designers and engineers are now finalising the detailed documentation ready to go out to tender. The design for the community building is also continuing to progress with the initial construction drawings now developed.

Commercial Centres Revitalisation Project Funding (CCRP)

Stage 1 was funded by the Commonwealth Government Department of Industry, Innovation and Science (Commonwealth Drought Extension Programme).

Stages 2 and 3 are funded by the Commonwealth Government Department of Industry, Science, Energy and Resources (Building Better Regions).
