

# Lameroo Town Centre Project (LTCP)

During February the project team has continued to work closely with LCS Landscapes to prepare for the start of works in Lameroo. This has included ordering materials, refining the implementation plans and updating the schedules.

# Pinnaroo Village Green Project (PVGP)

Construction of the new playspace in Pinnaroo is progressing well. LCS Landscapes have been busy undertaking the required earthworks and footings, constructing the central rock mound, installing the steel edging around the pathways, placing the timber logs into position and bringing in the softfall mulch.

Installation of the play equipment has begun with the tri-climbing net in place and construction of the sandpit complete. The remaining play equipment will continue to be installed throughout March.

Works at the Eastern end of the main street are also progressing well. Preparation of the footpath base and concrete edging is continuing. In the coming weeks asphalting the new footpath will occur and the planting works planned at this end of the street will begin.
