

# Commercial Centres Revitalisation Project Update #30 - July 2023

## Lameroo Town Centre Project (LTCP)

The East End Project works are progressing well. Two new 4x4m shelters have been installed along with new picnic settings.

24 Claret Ash trees have been planted along the street edge. The trees have been staked and mulched. The trees are deciduous and known for their claret coloured autumn foliage. As the project works progress these trees will be planted the entire length of the main street on the southern side.

The Stage 2 & 3 works have begun with the plans measured out onsite, demolition undertaken, and the initial ground works underway. The first section of paving is complete to the west of the Council Chambers. Paving works will continue into July with the planned brick wall seating expected to be constructed in the coming week.

Over the next month the fencing around the recreational area will be installed and the remainder of the footpath constructed along the street edge.

## Pinnaroo Village Green Project (PVGP)

The project works in Pinnaroo were completed last month and it has been great to see many families using the new playspace and the street amenities.

The Pinnaroo Community has been successful in securing some additional funding through Variety. This will allow for a sand table and elevated timber platform to be added to the playspace as sand play elements.

A BBQ will also be installed under the pavilion in front of the playspace. These items have been ordered and will be installed in the coming months. Congratulations to those involved in the successful grant application.
