

#### **Background**

Council works staff have over a period of time identified plant and equipment that has become surplus to Council's needs. Council at the July 2019 Ordinary meeting endorsed staff undertaking an Expression of Interest process for the sale of various plant and equipment.

#### Context

Council received a total of 14 submissions in response to the Expression of Interest process.

#### Policy and statutory implications

Council's Strategic Management Plan: Infrastructure strategies - 3.3 Ensure that infrastructure/assets are being used to their potential is also relevant to this matter.

#### Issues

The table below shows all of the Expressions of Interest submitted with the highest submission amount highlighted in bold text. The total value of the preferred Expressions of Interest is \$35,391 GST Inc.

Council did not receive an Expression of Interest for the Volvo prime mover, Mono pump or Fire fighter pump.

## **Alternate options**

The most appropriate option is for Council to accept the submission with the highest figure received in the Expression of Interest process. It is also appropriate for Council to advertise the remaining plant with an actual price on the item. This may attract more interest.

Council could decide to do nothing to the remaining items that did not receive an Expression of Interest, thus retaining and maintaining that plant. Council also put the remaining items through an Auction company with a reserved price.

## **Financial implications**

The cost to advertise the Expression of Interest in the newspapers. The process has generated income from asset sales of \$35,391.00.

## Work Health and Safety and Risk implications

This matter raises no work health and safety or risk issues.

#### Consultation

Council considered this matter at the ordinary Council meeting in July 2019 and resolved to advertise and seek an Expression of Interest for the sale of various items of plant. The process generated considerable public interest.
