

Commercial Centres Revitalisation Project Update #32 - September 2023

Pinnaroo Village Green Project (PVGP)

The project works in Pinnaroo were completed in June.

Lameroo Town Centre Project (LTCP)

The Stage 2 & 3 works in Lameroo are progressing well.

The mulch in and around the pump track has been removed and replaced with turf. The new turf looks fantastic, however, to allow the turf to establish the pump track is currently closed to the public. It will be re-opened as soon as possible. Additional areas of new turf have also been installed around the playground.

The stobie poles between the CWA building and the Council Office have been removed with the electricity supply moved underground. The paving works in this area are almost complete.

A new section of kerbing in front of the CFS Station and public toilets has been constructed. Preparation works are underway to extend the footpath and street trees through this area to provide continuity along the street edge.

Construction of the new one-way access road has continued with the initial earthworks and rubble installation well underway. Construction of this road will continue over the coming month.

Irrigation and landscaping works are also expected to continue throughout September.

Stage 2 & 3

- Funded by \$2.25m of Commonwealth Building Better Regions Funding.
- Council contribution of \$750,000.

Eastern Entrances

- Funded by \$561,847 of Commonwealth Local Roads & Community Infrastructure Funding.

Total Budget

- Over \$2.25m per project.
