

# Commercial Centres Revitalisation Project Update #35 - December 2023

## Lameroo Town Centre Project (LTCP)

In mid-November the poles for the new shade sails were installed around the playground edge. The contractors will be back on-site in the coming weeks to install the shade sails which are made to measure. Once installed, the shade sails will provide ample shade over the playground.

It has been fantastic to observe high utilisation of the new amenities and recreational spaces since the landscaping works were completed last month. In particular, it has been great to see a high number of caravans and RVs using the new access road and stopping in the designated parking area to explore the area.

In November a series of wayfinding signage was installed in the main street as part of the signage project. The signs complement the revitalisation project works and will help visitors navigate and explore the area.

## Pinnaroo Village Green Project (PVGP)

The project works in Pinnaroo were completed in June. This month the BBQ, which was recently installed under the shelter next to the playspace was connected. The BBQ can now be used by the community. This completes the additional works arranged through the Variety Club grant awarded to the Pinnaroo Community.

In November a series of wayfinding signage was installed in the main street as part of the signage project. The signs complement the revitalisation project works and will help visitors navigate and explore the area.
