

Commercial Centres Revitalisation Project Update #31 - August 2023

Lameroo Town Centre Project (LTCP)

The Stage 2 & 3 works are well underway, it has been a busy month of construction in the Lameroo main street.

A new 6 x 4m shelter complete with two picnic settings has been constructed between the playspace and pump track to provide additional shade and seating within the recreational area.

The concrete footpath, trees and fence have been installed along the street edge in front of the recreational area.

The paving works have continued around the Lameroo CWA and within the recreational area. Construction of the brick seating walls are almost complete.

Irrigation works have begun in preparation for new lawn and plantings to occur as part of the landscaping works. Irrigation works are expected to continue throughout the month.

Construction of the new one-way access road has begun with the initial earthworks underway, and the cement poured for the western entry.



Pinnaroo Village Green Project (PVGP)

The project works in Pinnaroo were completed in June and despite the cold weather the new playspace and amenities has continued to be well utilised by both the community and visitors to the area.

Commercial Centres Revitalisation Project Funding (CCRP)

Stage 1 was funded by the Commonwealth Government Department of Industry, Innovation and Science (Commonwealth Drought Extension Programme).

Stage 2 & 3 are funded by the Commonwealth Government Department of Industry, Science, Energy and Resources (Building Better Regions).

The Eastern Entrance projects are funded by the Commonwealth Government of Infrastructure, Transport, Regional Development and Communications (Local Roads and Community Infrastructure Program).

Total Budget
