# **Executive Summary**

This report enables Council to award the tender for the termite inspection and spider treatment program for Council properties for a five year period.

Council allocates operational budget annually for this ongoing service.

Council sent invitations for an expressions of interest process for this program of works to three companies. Two companies submitted tenders. The tenders were evaluated against predetermined tender assessment criteria. The preferred tenderer is Terminix Pest and Weed Control Pty Ltd for a contract price of \$48,609.96.

That Council awards the contract for the Termite Inspection and Spider Treatment Program for Council Properties for the period 2021/22 – 2025/26 to Terminix Pest and Weed Control Pty Ltd for a contract price of \$48,609.96 (ex GST).

## **Background**

Council's Strategic Plan, Goal 3 identifies the need to invest in building and maintaining high-quality assets for our community. Council's investment into annual pest control activities will help ensure that public assets are monitored for pests and ensuring that people using these facilities aren't impacted by insects and spiders. Pests can have a serious adverse effect on the integrity of a building.

Council has historically engaged a third party provider to undertake the annual program of termite inspections, spider and insect treatments on all Council properties. A limited tender process was undertaken with identified companies that already operate within the council area in.

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#### Context

Council sent invitations to participate in the expression of interest process to three companies: No Stress Pest Control; Murray Pest Control and Terminix Pest and Weed Control. The tender period opened 10 March 2021 and closed 5.00pm 9 April 2021.

# Policy and statutory implications

Council has a procurement policy and the tender process has been undertaken in accordance with the policy.

All Council purchases must be carried out in compliance with the Local Government Act 1999 (the Act). Section 49 (a1) of the Act requires Council to develop and maintain procurement policies, practices and procedures directed towards:

- Obtaining value in the expenditure of public money, and
- Providing for ethical and fair treatment of participants, and
- Ensuring probity, accountability and transparency in the procurement process.

Council is not obliged to accept the lowest tender or any tender.

#### Issues

Two tenders were submitted. They were from No Stress Pest Control and Terminix Pest and Weed Control. The tenders were evaluated against set assessment criteria by a tender panel comprising the Manager Property and Development and both of Council's Property and Development Services Officers.

Tender prices provided by each company are all GST exclusive. Both tenders were deemed to be conforming. A bid comparison summary and detailed tender evaluation is provided as an attachment to this report. Terminix Pest and Weed Control Pty Ltd scored well and was the most competitively priced, with a contract price of \$48,609.96.

# Alternate options

Council could accept a different tender firm. This is not recommended and if this did occur the reasons for this decision should be documented.

# Financial implications

The cost of the termite inspection and spider treatment program is provided for as an operational cost in each annual budget.

## Work Health and Safety and Risk implications

The submitted tenders included work health and safety components. There are no risk implications associated with this matter.

#### Consultation

The expression of interest process was open to three companies.
