

Commercial Centres Revitalisation Project Update #16 - November 2021

Pinnaroo Village Green Project (PVGP)

The Stage 1 works are looking fantastic, with lots of positive feedback from within the community about the new street appeal.

The landscaping works are progressing well with turf, trees and plantings all going in recently.

The street paving is almost complete, the paths have been asphalted and the totems out the front of the MT&HC have been installed.



Preparation for the works at the war memorial have begun and the North/South connection path will also be constructed in the coming weeks.

Wax Design are progressing the detailed design of Stages 2 & 3. The on-site civil engineering and environmental testing works have been completed; the results will inform the design as it progresses towards completion.

Lameroo Town Centre Plan (LTCP)

The centre pivot has been installed in the Lameroo playground. The structure looks very impressive from the street front and has provided the addition of swings to the play space.

The shelter has also been installed, with the picnic setting expected to be added in the coming week.

The addition of the picnic setting will see the completion of Stage 1 in Lameroo.



The project team met with Birdseye Studios this week to discuss the Stages 2 & 3 design progress. This work will continue to progress with the aim of being completed by end of calendar year or early in 2022.

Commercial Centres Revitalisation Project Funding (CCRP)

Stage 1 is funded by the Commonwealth Government Department of Industry, Innovation and Science (Commonwealth Drought Extension Programme).

Stages 2 and 3 are funded by the Commonwealth Government Department of Industry, Science, Energy and Resources (Building Better Regions).
