Backhoe Tender Summary 2016

Council has undertaken an selective tender for the supply and delivery of 1 Backhoe to replace the current 2003 Caterpillar 432D Backhoe

The 3 Company's selected were

Errol Matschoss Motors [JCB]

Hitachi Australia [John Deere]

Cavpower [Caterpillar]

2 Council staff members and myself travelled to Adelaide on Tuesday 20 September to appraise the 3 Backhoe's, however due to Hitachi [John Deere] not having a Backhoe available at this time [tried to source one] only the JCB and Caterpillar Backhoe were looked at.

Backhoe's appraised were JCB 3CX Elite, Caterpillar 432F with the John Deere 315SL being appraised on the Tender documents solely.

From the information supplied by the staff and the evaluation process undertaken the recommendation would be for Council to purchase the Caterpillar 432F2 Backhoe

Even though the price is over the budget figure of \$160,000 by \$6,538 if you take into consideration the extra \$5,000 on the trade then the price is \$1,538 over the budget change over figure

Rubbish Truck Tender Summary 2016

Council has undertaken a public Tender advertised on the SA Tenders website for the supply and delivery of a new 24m3 rubbish truck

From this tender process there was one [1] submission from Superior Pak and in that submission there were 5 different Cab Chassis [trucks] to choose from.

Also as previously mentioned in a Council meeting ,Karoonda East Murray Council is progressing with setting up recycling by way of a kerbside pickup, which by discussions I have had briefly with their CEO it may be not too far away. Taking this into consideration and the ability for this to be incorporated in the Lameroo/ Geranium run on the 2nd Tuesday of the month, I also sought a price to go to a 27m3 rubbish truck to give some more capacity. The added cost to go from a 24m3 to a 27m3 is \$1,500

Below is a table of the prices for the cab chassis fully complete with the Superior Pak 27m3 Body which for the extra cost of \$1,500 more is what Council should be looking at.

All trucks would surfice the Council in what they would be used for , however given that the Hino FM and the Izuzu FXY 1500 both require a IQAN cotrol system to interface with Superior pak system and they need wheel base reductions the recommendation would be to stay away from these 2

The Dennis Eagle, Iveco and Volvo all have good reputations within the industry. Council staff have indicated that the Volvo would be the preferred option due to the having knowledge of Volvo trucks, comfortable ride, visibility and backup service

Therfore taking into consideration Council staff input and the genuine knowledge of the Volvo trucks for this type of work the **recommendation to**Council is to purchase the Volvo FE Euro 6x4 Airbag 5180 WB

The price of \$354,387 is over the budgeted price of \$350,000 by \$4,387
