What's changed?

Pinnaroo Village Green Project (PVGP)

Stage 1 works are close to completion. Over the last month construction around the war memorial has progressed well, with the design reinvigorating the surrounding area.

The north south path is complete, and the landscaping works continue to progress well with the addition of more turf, trees, and plantings.

A new shelter has been constructed which will provide a great social space for the community to utilise as well as visitors to the town.

The detailed design for Stages 2 & 3 continues to progress well with the 100% design expected to be presented to the Steering Committee in the new year.

Stage 1

- Funded by \$1m of Commonwealth Drought Funding.

Stage 2 & 3

- Funded by \$2.25m of Commonwealth Building Better Regions Funding.
- Council contribution of \$750,000.

Total Budget

- \$2m per project.
