

Commercial Centres Revitalisation Project Update #18 - February 2022

Lameroo Town Centre Plan (LTCP)

In Lameroo, the Stages 2 & 3 design is now the focus for the project team. Birdseye Studios is busily preparing the 50% design and will present this to the Steering Committee in the coming weeks.

Stages 2 & 3 of the project in Lameroo will focus on the addition of a central plaza area, village green, water splash pad, 2 new toilet amenities, street trees, paving and fencing the playspace.



Stage 1 works were completed last year with the community providing lots of positive feedback on the transformation of the main street area.

The town Christmas festivities proved to be a great chance for the community to come together and enjoy the new open space areas. We look forward to continuing to see both the community and visitors to the town utilising the refreshed main street.

The detailed design for Stages 2 & 3 is close to being finalised. Wax Design will present the 100% design to the Steering Committee on Tuesday 1 February.

Stages 2 & 3 of the project focus on the development of a new playspace, recreation paths, bike adventure trails and a detention basin.
